- I. *You shall have no other gods before Me.*

- III. *You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain.*
- IV. *Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.*
- V. *Honor your father and your mother.*
- VI. *You shall not murder.*
- VII. *You shall not commit adultery.*
- VIII. *You shall not steal.*
- IX. *You shall not bear false witness.*
- X. *You shall not covet.*

Sermon Notes

A Christ-centered Exposition of Psalm 15 *“Qualified for God’s Presence?”*

Introduction

The Lord reveals who may dwell in His presence (v. 1):

1. We must be blameless inwardly and outwardly. (vv. 2-5)
 - a. In our speech and actions. (vv. 2-3)
 - b. In our relations with the ungodly and the godly. (v. 4a)
 - c. In our promises. (v. 4b)
 - d. In our financial integrity. (v. 5a-b)
2. If we are righteous in these ways, we will be forever secure in God's presence. (v. 5c)
3. Christ alone perfectly fulfills these qualifications for us – and works these qualities in us.

Who We Are, What We Do, and Why:

Biblical & Historic – we worship in accord with the ancient Western liturgy, reformed according to the Scripture.

Reformed – we confess the historic creeds, adhere to the Westminster Standards, appreciate the Three Forms of Unity, and govern the church according to Presbyterian polity.

Church – we assemble as one part of the universal church, appointed by Christ as the means by which His people of all nations would be gathered and grow in grace.
